

#### Introduction

- The 20L Hybrid PET kegs come sterilised and purged with gas ready to fill for the first time.
- They use a standard Type A coupler used by Tooheys, Coopers and XXXX.
- They are manufactured from PET with a small proportion of nylon and a brown colorant. Fittings are made from plastic materials: POM, PP, TPE and a stainless-steel metal spring.
- Operating pressure consistently up to 3 bar (43psi), burst pressure of 7 bar
- Light and easy to monitor beer levels

### **Filling**

- Use the clear plastic cap supplied to vent excess pressure from the keg by pushing it down on the white top of the keg.
- Attach you filling hose to the top of your type A Coupler.
- Remove the gas side fitting from your type A coupler including the silicon duck valve.
- Attach the type A coupler to your keg
- Insert the filling tube to the tap of your fermenter
- Open the tap and allow the keg to fill
- Fill as high as possible
- Remove the coupler

# **Carbonating**

Carbonate your beverages the same way you would with any other type of keg. The Hybrid keg easily operates normal carbonating pressures.

## Cleaning

Once empty, using your type A coupler and a funnel, fill the keg with 1 tsp of Sodium percarbonate in 2 litres of warm water and shake vigorously. Drain and repeat with fresh water and then with a no rinse sanitiser.

### Refilling

Prior to refilling, use your type A coupler with the liquid side adapter removed to purge the keg with Co2. Once purged, proceed to fill as normal.
